- Work may not exceed 25 x 30 inches in height or width and must be framed and wired.
- Members of the selection jury are ineligible to submit work.

REQUIREMENTS

A photograph or jpg image along with your contact information, bio, medium and size of your work must be received no later than October 12, 2007:

- Artists will be notified by phone and email by October 19th if their work is accepted for the exhibit

DROP OFF

- Selected work to be delivered between 9:00 AM and noon on Thursday, October 25, 2007 to the Riverside Ballroom at the Inn at Lambertville Station.
- A \$40 non refundable entry fee is required.
- Artists will be responsible for handling their own work.
Exhibit will open to the public at 6 PM.
Winners to be announced at 7 PM.

REMOVAL

- Artists will be responsible for removing unsold paintings by 10 PM.
- A signed authorization is required if someone other than the submitting artist picks up your unsold work.

INSURANCE

Great care will be taken to protect the work of each artist, however the artist is completely responsible for the insurance of their work for the duration of the Exhibit. The Lambertville Station will not be held liable for any damage, theft or accidental destruction of any works submitted.

SALES

All works must be for sale.
